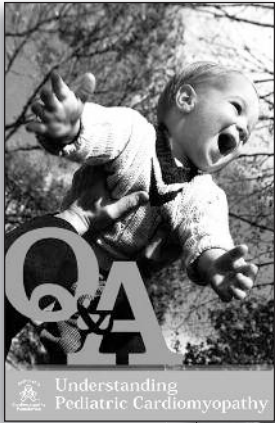


# PATIENT EDUCATION MATERIALS

## Understanding Pediatric Cardiomyopathy

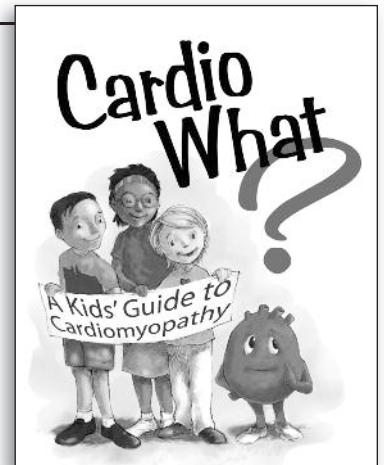

The easy-to-understand booklet covers topics such as causes, diagnosis, symptoms, treatments, family screening, coping, and research. Developed after in-depth patient and physician research, **Understanding Pediatric Cardiomyopathy** is an essential resource for parents, caregivers, and healthcare professionals.

## Cardio What? A Kids' Guide to Cardiomyopathy

Developed in collaboration with the National Society of Genetic Counselors, this 29-page booklet uses child-friendly language, colorful illustrations, and fun activities to help children understand their own or another family member's diagnosis of cardiomyopathy. Children will enjoy reading **Cardio What?** with a parent, relative, or older sibling as they learn about their heart condition.

**Cardio What?** is a great resource for genetic counselors, geneticists, pediatric cardiologists, social workers, cardiac nurses, child life specialists, or anybody else that needs to explain cardiomyopathy to a child.



## Secrets of the Heart – Living with Pediatric Cardiomyopathy

This 38-minute video presents the unique stories of three different families, all who have successfully lived through the challenges related to cardiomyopathy. You will learn about two cousins who have overcome two very different cases of hypertrophic cardiomyopathy. You will meet a mother and her young son, who was diagnosed with restrictive cardiomyopathy at the age of two and transplanted only a few months later. You will also be inspired by the story of two sisters and how they have bravely dealt with dilated cardiomyopathy throughout their lives. These heart-felt stories are interwoven with valuable information from top cardiomyopathy experts.

This educational resource provides knowledge and comfort to families trying to cope with the uncertainties of living with cardiomyopathy. Viewable from a DVD machine or computer, the video can be shown to families in-hospital or given out with other patient materials during clinic visits.

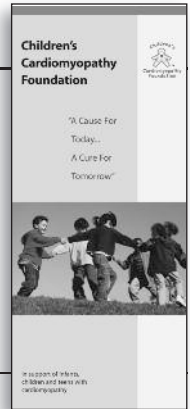


# Heart to Heart Newsletter
